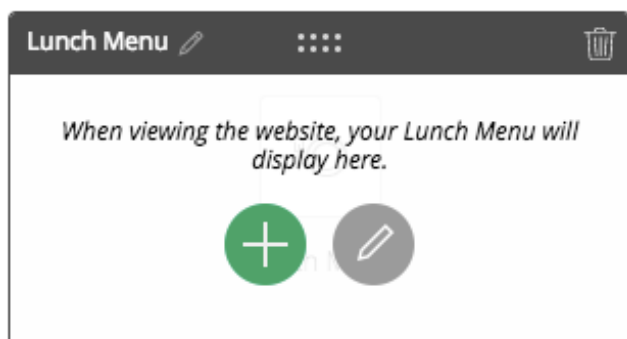


1. Select the *Date* for the menu.
